- **Form:** Word.

- **Number of words:** 1000-1500 words in arial.
- **Title:** Include a short and interesting title, remember the audience is international
- **Author or authors:** Include your complete name, a 50-word maximum brief bio and if you want, social media and contact information for each author.
- **Voice:** Use readable text in active voice.
- **References:** These are optional, but if you include some, name the sources in the article and reference them fully at the end as a list, and, if wanted, create a link to the source.
- **Figures, tables and Pictures:** Include a picture or illustration that can be shared on media. Can also include a figure or table.
- **Hashtags:** Include 3 keywords of your article as hasthags # (will always also include #GELYDA #ExtendedEducation and #ThrivingWorldwide).
- **Sharing:** please share with colleagues and your social media.
- **Include your article in other media:** Articles can be shared in other media publications citing the original source and letting GELYDA know through our contact. *“This article was originally published by GELYDA’s Blog “Thriving Worldwide”.*
- **Sending and edit of your blog:** Send to GELYDA’S contact mail for our editing team revises it and be in contact with you. Please include your contact information.
